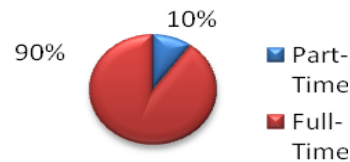

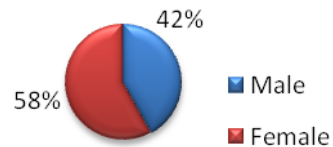

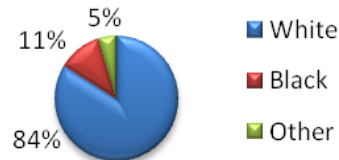
Percent Enrolled by Status
